Introduction

Authors are invited to submit a **two-page** abstract that summarises the main features of the contribution. The abstract must be written in English and contain the full name(s) and address(es) of all authors. Template files can be downloaded in LaTeX format and should be converted to Portable Document Format (PDF) after editing. Please submit the PDF file by email to GKB-100@maths.cam.ac.uk. The deadline for submission is **15 December 2019**. Notification of acceptance will be communicated by 17 January 2020.

Detailed instructions

The text may but does not have to be structured in sections such as “Introduction”, “Materials and methods”, “Results”, etc. Please write your abstract using the LaTeX template provided. Please make sure that after conversion to PDF, your final document does not exceed two pages!

Editing the LaTeX-file Unzip the zip-archive *GKB100.zip* and edit the file *template-GKB100.tex*. Fill in the title of your presentation, authors, affiliations, e-mail address of the corresponding author and the abstract. Equations like this

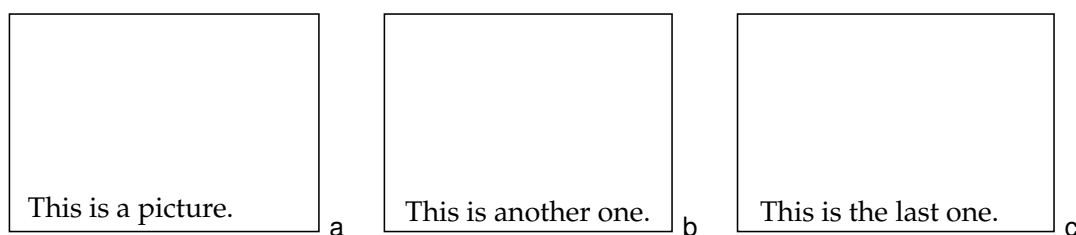


Fig. 1: These are three pictures in one figure: the first (a), the second (b) and the last one (c).

$$x^2 + y^2 = z^2 \quad (1)$$

or pictures like Fig. 1 can be included. Help on typesetting LaTeX documents can e.g. be found in [1].

For lists and enumerations, the environments “GKB100-list” and “GKB100-num” are available, e.g.

- an item
- another one.

Formatting references References should be numbered in the order of their appearance in the text and formatted as given in the examples. Journal articles should, for example, be cited as [2, 3], books and conference proceedings like [4, 5], respectively.

Abstract submission

Finally, please convert the edited file to a PDF, save it such that its name begins with the presenting author’s surname and submit it by e-mail to GKB-100@maths.cam.ac.uk by **15 December 2019**.
